

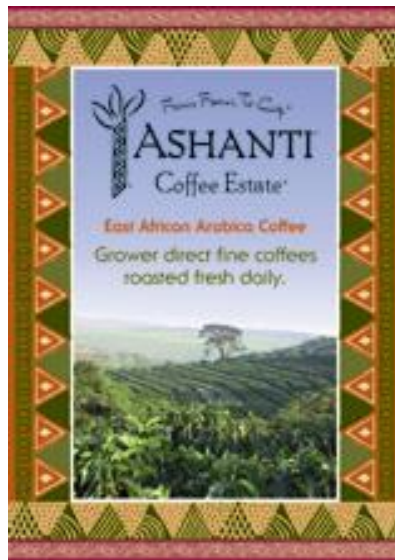
# FORMOSA LIONS FARMERS NIGHT
